## GRENACHE SYRAH



### **Terroir**

We vinify grapes sourced from a variety of different terroirs in the Languedoc, including cool-climate sites at higher elevations. The Grenache is cultivated in the Terraces of Pepieux while our Syrah vines make their home in the cooler parts of Carcassonne.

### **Vinification**

The aim is to produce a concentrated and fruit-driven wine that can be enjoyed immediately. After the berries are crushed, we ferment the juice at different temperatures to combine fruit preservation with sufficient extraction of tannin; ripe and approachable tannins are a hallmark of this wine.

### **Tasting Notes**

An intense nose features damson, raspberry, and a hint of black pepper. The palate has vibrancy and poise that is balanced by concentrated red fruits and silky tannins. A long, lingering finish delivers mulberry and violets – a spectacular finale. This will shine alongside grilled meats and beef daube.
