Terroir

The vineyards, selected from high-yielding vines, come from the areas of Carcassonne and the Minervois, in association with Celliers Jean d'Alibert.

Vinification

The Grenache grapes were picked at optimum aromatic ripeness and then pressed to avoid color extraction and only then the clear juice was racked. The juice was coldly fermented, and the wine remained on lees for 3 months before being prepared for bottling.

Tasting Notes

Pink with slight violet tones. Intense aromas of bramble, strawberry and recurrent with a hint of pepper. Fresh palette with refreshing bright red fruit and peppery character. Apparently dry with attractive sweetness. To be drunk by itself or with a range of dishes, including ones that are made with oriental spices.
